

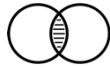

What will I know by the end of this unit of work?

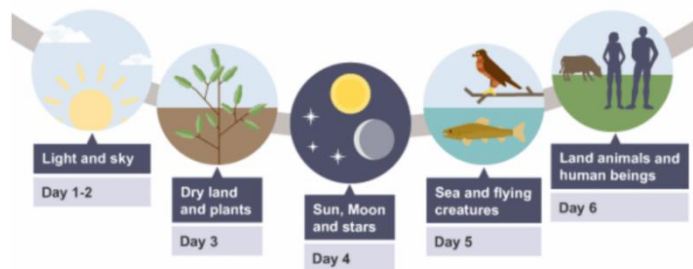
- That a most religious traditions believe that God made the world and so it is precious,

The Christian Creation Story

The Islamic Creation Story
