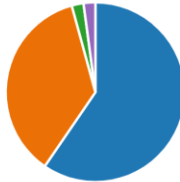
My child is happy at this school

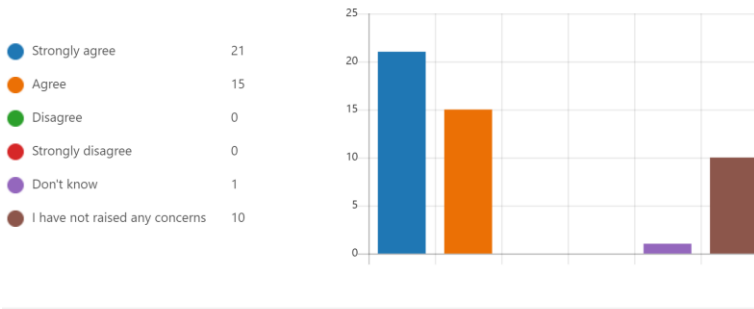

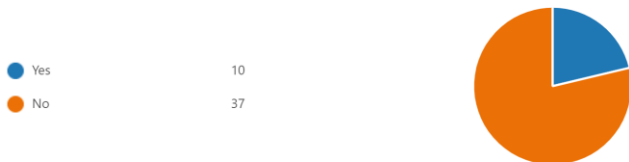

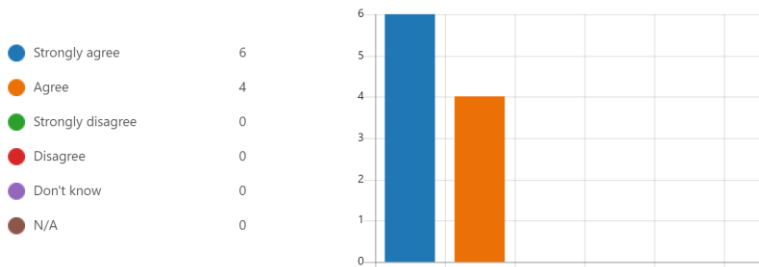
When I have raised concerns the school have dealt with the issue effectively and a resolution has been found.



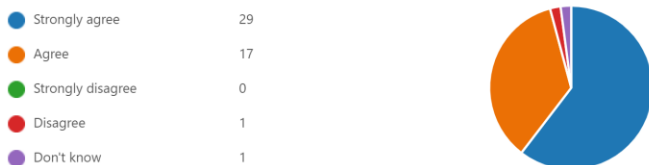
Does your child have special educational needs or disabilities?
